Places per year	We mainly accept exchange students from partner universities within a bilateral agreement with the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences.
	Courses of Medicine or courses in Rehabilitation Sciences and Physiotherapy Some courses of our Bachelor and Master programme are taught in English to accommodate international students ('green courses'). Besides these 'English courses' we also offer courses with facilities for exchange students ('yellow courses'). These courses are taught in Dutch but the lecturers provide facilities (e.g. study material, handbook, exam,) in English. Exchange students are not accepted in the Dutch courses except if the student can proof Dutch language knowledge of level C1.
	Clinical traineeships Exchange students can be accepted for a clinical traineeships in blocks of 4 or 8 weeks, according to the fix rotation system of the hospital and depending on the availability in the clinical ward.
Academic calendar	As the academic calendar is divided into 2 semesters an exchange student can come to the UAntwerp either in the Autumn or the Spring semester. During the Summer holidays (July and August) the medical staff in the hospital is understaffed, which makes it difficult to have a clinical traineeship.

Restrictions	Exchange students must be in their 4th or higher study year of Medicine studies; for studies in Rehabilitation Sciences and Physiotherapy an exchange student must be in the 3 <sup>rd</sup> study year. There is a limited availability of training placements. A traineeship is always to ask at the contact person of the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences.

Study plan	Exchange students can pick courses from several years (3 <sup>rd</sup> Bachelor, 1 <sup>st</sup> Master, 2 <sup>nd</sup> Master).  However, it is not allowed to choose 'overlapping courses'.  It is advised to send a draft of the proposed study programme before sending the final Learning Agreement.
