A. General part

1. Course objectives

Students get acquainted with the US machine and how to improve US image. The importance and possibilities of using US in medicine with an emphasis on the use in anaesthesia are presented. They learn to distinguish and correctly use different US probes. Theoretical lectures on the use of US are continued by performing examination on the models or in simulation centre. They learn to use US for i.v. access and regional anaesthesia. They understand the importance of US diagnostics in determining the patient's hemodynamic instability and the basics of the US examination of the heart and lungs.

2. Comprehensive outline of the course organisation

Lectures and practical work on models. After the lecture, the practical work on models follow each lecture. Compulsory 75% presence.

3. Description of on-going assessment of knowledge and skills

No assessment of on-going knowledge and skills are planned.

4. Required conditions for the final examination (Course Exam)

The condition for the final examination is 75% attendance at lectures and exercises. In case of justified absence, additional lectures and practical work are organized by agreement.

5. Final assessment and examination of knowledge and skills (Course Exam)

Final examination of knowledge is a written exam consisting of 20 MCQs, lasting 1 hour, 60% for a positive assessment.
