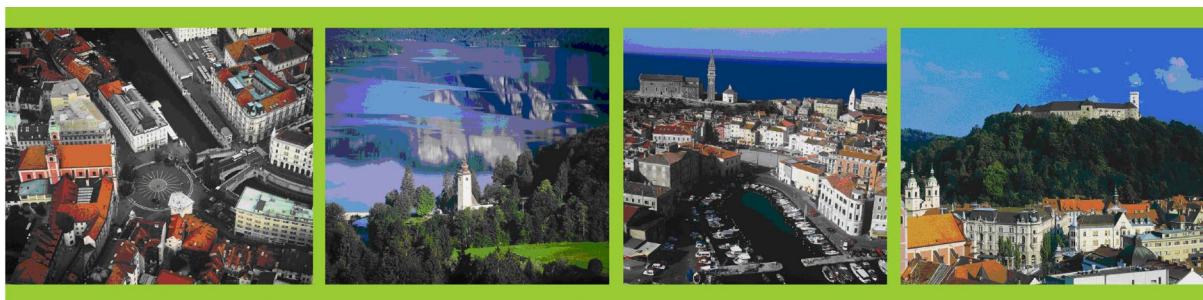

BACKGROUND

The Faculty of Medicine is one of the 22 faculties and 3 art academies which belong to the University of Ljubljana, the largest and oldest higher education institution in Slovenia. The University of Ljubljana was founded in 1919; one of the founding faculties was also the Faculty of Medicine. In 2019 our faculty celebrated 100 years of existence, this seems to be a short period in comparison with other medical faculties in our neighbourhood, but it reflexes a long period of medicine development in our country. An important role in the development of medical education was played by dr. Oražen, who left his heritage to the faculty and its students in the form of two Oražen's campus buildings. Initially, the study at the Faculty of Medicine lasted only for four semesters; the fifth and the sixth semester were added in 1940. During Italian and German occupation in the Second World War the Faculty ceased to function. In 1945, the complete Faculty of Medicine was founded. It has since developed two Departments: Dept. of Medicine and Dept. of Dental Medicine. Graduate study has also developed successfully, which has become largely interdisciplinary. The Faculty of Medicine co-operates closely with the Faculty of Pharmacy and other institutions of higher education in Slovenia. Currently 1600 medical, dental medical and PhD students are enrolled. Dean of the Faculty is Prof. dr. Igor Švab, Vice Dean for Medicine is Prof. dr. Tomaž Marš, Vice Dean for Dental Medicine is Prof. dr. Janja Jan, Vice Dean for Research is Prof. dr. Ksenija Geršak and Vice Dean for professional activities Prof. dr. Miroslav Petrovec.

The majority of clinical chairs and institutes are located in close proximity of the Deanery and University Clinical Centre, a teaching hospital of the Faculty.

ACADEMIC YEAR

The integrated master's study programmes Medicine and Dental Medicine are organised in accordance with the National Higher Education Programme and lasts for 6 years (12 semesters). Current curriculum and a brief description of subject's content is available on the

website: https://www.mf.uni-lj.si/download_file/view/20195/15066 (Medicine) and (Dental medicine) https://www.mf.uni-lj.si/download_file/view/20719/15066 It is divided in preclinical (first 5 semesters) and clinical courses (last 7 semesters).

Academic year 2025/2026 is officially divided into a winter (fall) and summer (spring) semester, but due to the organisation of the courses and examination periods there are no holidays/semester breaks between semesters from the 4th until including 6th year. Officially, the winter semester starts on **October 1st 2025** and ends on **January 16th 2026**. The examination periods are set at the end of every course. Officially the spring semester starts on **February 9th 2026** and ends on **June 12th 2026**. The spring examination period follows at the end of the spring semester. There are planned holidays during the Christmas & New Year's and later during 1st May holidays.

When taking into consideration your individual study obligations your individual schedule (will be given to you prior to your arrival by e-mail) is the most important document and the only relevant document in your case! **You have to be present in Ljubljana on all the dates when you have scheduled obligations!**

!Application procedure for exchange students!

1. **ERASMUS+**: Your home university should first nominate you to the Office of International Relations of the University of Ljubljana. The nominations should be sent primarily to the Central International office of University of Ljubljana (UL): intern.office@uni-lj.si and to the International office of the Faculty of Medicine UL: international.erasmus@mf.uni-lj.si

OTHER STUDENTS: Your home university should nominate you to the International office of the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Ljubljana. The nominations should be sent to international.erasmus@mf.uni-lj.si Only a limited number of applications from non Erasmus students can be processed and confirmed during the academic year.

2. After your home university has nominated you to study at the University of Ljubljana as an exchange student, you should fill our online application available at: https://studij.uni-lj.si/studexchange/tujci_prva.asp There is no need to send a paper copy of the application. The host faculty in our case is the Faculty of Medicine.

3. At the end of the online application you will find the necessary documents to upload to your application: Transcript of Records (of your home university), Learning Agreement, Language Certificate and a copy of your personal ID/passport. Your application is complete and will be processed only after you have completed all the steps of the application system and entered all the required information and documents.

4. After we have received your application and your host department (Faculty of Medicine, University of Ljubljana) has approved your application and acceptance, the University of Ljubljana will send you the general information on living and studying in Ljubljana (for the first semester and whole exchange in June 2025 and for the second semester in December 2025). You can download or print the official Acceptance letter from the application page once your application will be processed and confirmed.

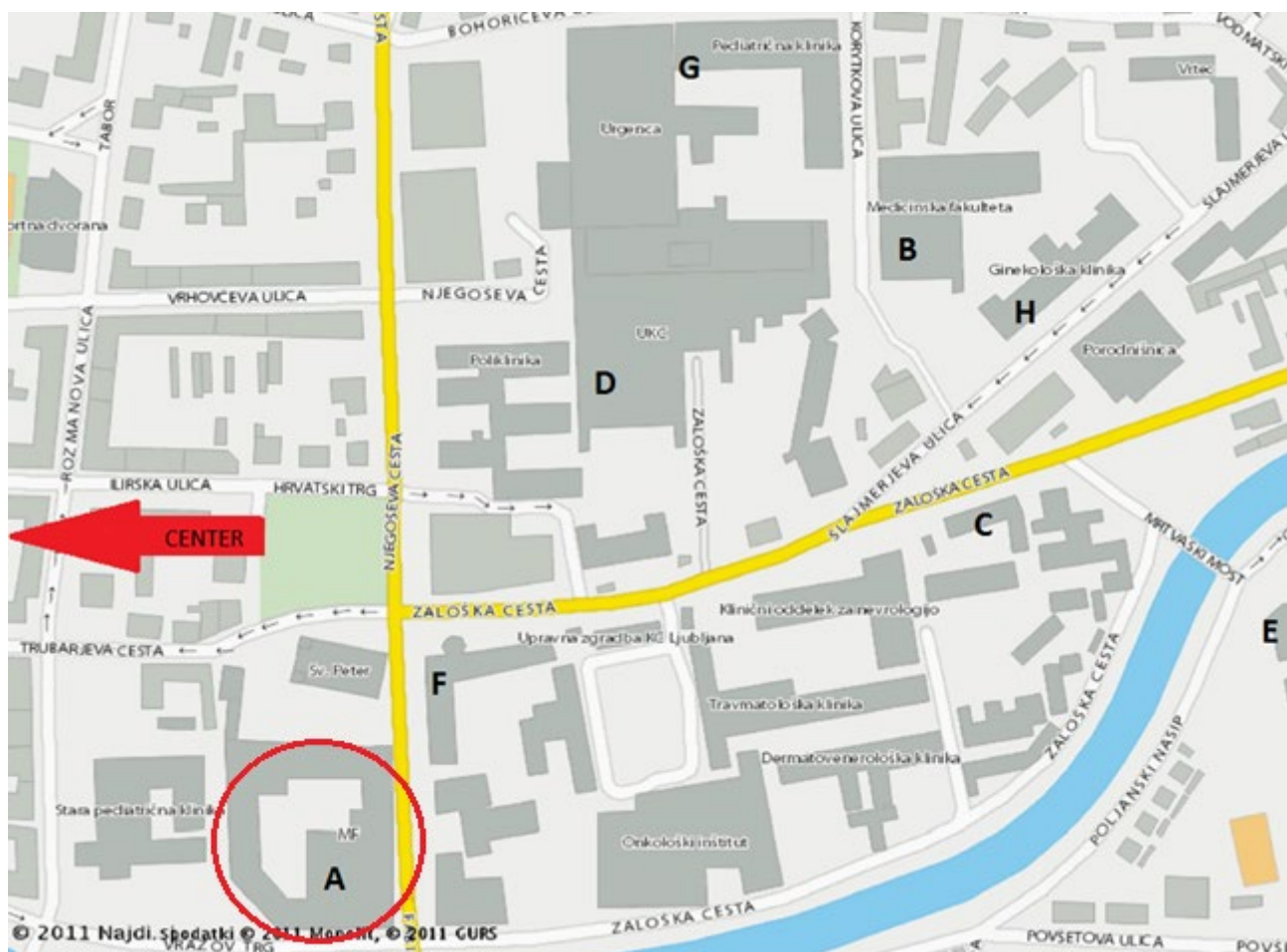

3) Introduction/Welcome week

Obligatory welcome reception for all incoming students starting their exchange in the first semester will be held in the last days of September, with several activities organised, the official welcome day will be held on **29th September 2025 (10:00, Faculty of Medicine, Korytkova str. 2, middle lecture room)**. Students starting with their programme already in the summer (starting gynaecology or paediatrics) must report to the international office a few days before the start of the exchange!

Students, coming to Ljubljana in the second semester will get the information about the welcome days later. We will organise welcome days at the end of January/early February and late February 2026.

Your attendance at the Welcome days/Introduction workshops in September 2025 is MANDATORY! Please arrange your arrival in Ljubljana well in advance.

Each incoming student must bring their own: **white coat and white T-shirt/trousers appropriate for clinical work** (shirt, skirt, trousers, and appropriate if possible white coloured light shoes), **basic equipment for clinical examination** (stethoscope, hand bin-light, neurological hammer, a meter for measurement). There is no chance of borrowing the uniform at the hospital, there is only the chance of buying them at the Faculty of Medicine.

Language requirements and provisional schedule 2025/2026

The programme in Medicine and Dental medicine **is in general taught in Slovenian language**, but Erasmus+ students are enrolled in rotation groups with the local students called **“International group”**, in which exchange students participate together with our students. Subjects/courses for the “International group” are held partly or completely (varies for individual subject/course) in English. **Fluent knowledge of English is OBLIGATORY (proof of**

B2 Level language knowledge is required). Students who will not be able to communicate in English will be rejected.

For all obligatory study forms (practical/laboratory work, clinical rotations, seminars and electives) nominated academic tutors will conduct and give support to Erasmus+ exchange students in English, if possible.

Each subject is for the exchange students ("International group") organised in English only once during the academic year, only and exclusively in the periods, stated in the schedule 2025/2026 and available to Erasmus+ incoming students: https://www.mf.uni-lj.si/download_file/view/20535/15066 It is not possible to combine/attend subjects from 3rd year with the subjects from 4th and 5th year, if they are organised in the same period of time, even if the collision is only in one week!! (especially the case of Anaesthesiology) * Some subjects of the 3rd year (Clinical Microbiology, Pathology, Pathophysiology, and Pharmacology) do not have a specific scheduled period and will be held through the academic year.

Incoming students will be allowed **to take exams only if they complete the whole programme and all the requirements set for specific subject**. Exam can be provided only if the student applies for it in the Faculty of Medicine UL student online application system ("VIS"). Exams will be provided only on specific examinations dates, settled by the departments. Instructions will be given at the Welcome reception. Exams are normally organised after the course finishes that means that the students can do most of the exams already during the academic year and not only during the examination period. Please see the schedule of courses.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: We do not offer to the students the possibility to obtain the grades for their clinical rotations. Therefore, we are already now informing you that **in case you will need to obtain the grades/assessment of your clinical practice you have to submit to your mentor and International Office prior to the beginning of the Clinical rotations an Official document from your home university where it is clearly stated which skills and knowledge should be assessed by your mentor**. If you don't have the assessment form from your home university you can use the one from our faculty: https://www.mf.uni-lj.si/download_file/view/9579/15066 The grade will be included in the final Transcript of Records (as annex) with the information that you **have been assessed** but not examined according to the assessment document as provided by your home university.

GENERAL REGULATIONS AND ORGANISATION OF CLINICAL ROTATIONS for Internal Medicine, Surgery, Gynaecology/Obstetrics and Paediatrics

Clinical rotations (CRs) are available for:

1. Students, registered in the 6th or final year of their study while on exchange (internal medicine and surgery) *
2. Students, registered in the 4th or 5th year of their study while being on exchange, if the following conditions are fulfilled:
 - In chosen fields/clinical dept's, if they submit undoubted proof (Transcript of Records), where there is clear that they completed and have been assessed/examined in subject applicable
 - If they complete and pass assessment/examination of a modul/subject (for example Respiratory system for CR in Thoracic surgery or Pulmonology-Internal Medicine) while on exchange in Ljubljana
 - CR can be provided only and exclusively in the periods, which do not collide with on-going and pre-scheduled subjects and can be arranged exclusively through the International Office, in all cases CRs must be included in the Learning Agreement, signed by all three sides (student, receiving and sending institution coordinator!)

*CR can be done in max. two fields/dept's for Surgery in min. duration of three (3) weeks per field/dept's or in max. three fields valid for Internal Medicine in min. duration of two (2) weeks per field/dept's, each week (5 days, min. 6 hours/day of practice) of CR completed will be credited with 2 ECTS.

Surgery CR: the students, who will attend the clinical rotations in Surgery must prepare and present during the rotations one seminar paper and present it to his mentor. Please discuss the topic of the seminar paper with your clinical mentor.

IMPORTANT!!! Students who won't obey these regulations and will arrange their CR on their own bypassing the International Office and Dept's Offices or will do CR without being pre-arranged in Learning Agreements, will not have the activity recognised in the final documents.

!!! CLINICAL ROTATIONS IN SURGERY!!!

Students who will attend the clinical rotations in Surgery must **before finishing the CR, present and submit a seminar paper on a certain surgical topic which they arrange with the mentors.**

Students always start their clinical rotations in surgery on Mondays at 7 o'clock so you must make sure that you arrive to Ljubljana a couple of days earlier to arrange all the details on time. At the first day at 7 o'clock you must present yourself at the clinical department already in the uniform and with the access to the wardrobe lockers where you can leave your personal things (please see number 13 of the welcome guide).

!!!CLINICAL ROTATIONS IN INTERNAL MEDICINE!!!

All clinical rotations in Internal Medicine are organised at the University Clinical Centre and at the Hospital of dr. Peter Držaj in Ljubljana. In case of Pulmonology only 3 students per semester get the chance to be placed in Ljubljana, all other candidates will do the practice at the Clinic in Golnik.

Students always start their clinical rotations in internal medicine on Mondays so you must make sure that you arrive to Ljubljana a couple of days earlier so that you can arrange all the details on time. Normally the first day starts at 8:30.

FAMILY MEDICINE (PRIMARY HEALTH CARE) Subject and Clinical rotation

In the academic year 2025/2026 we will only be able to offer the students the whole subject Primary Health Care (lectures, seminars, clinical practice) exclusively in the period stated in the schedule for 2025/2026. Should students have any additional requirements, this needs to be coordinated with the Academic Coordinator for Primary Health Care (Prof. dr. Danica Rotar) at latest until 15th November 2025.

Clinical practice in Family Medicine can be only provided on a special request and confirmation from the department if there are mentors available. Clinical practice in family medicine can only be placed outside the city of Ljubljana and in some places throughout the country. Subsidised prices of the monthly transport tickets will be available.

Students always start their clinical rotations in family Medicine on Mondays so you must make sure that you arrive to Ljubljana a couple of days earlier so that you can arrange all the details on time.

7)

ACCIDENT INSURANCE, LIABILITY INSURANCE AND HEALTH INSURANCE

Incoming Erasmus+ students must arrange their own health and accident insurance valid as well in the time of their exchange in Ljubljana. Additionally, students who will do the CR in Surgery and Internal Medicine must arrange the liability insurance which is either covered from their home university or done on an individual basis by the student. The Faculty of Medicine of the University of Ljubljana cannot cover the costs of accidents in the time of CR of the incoming students. If such

insurance is not arranged by the student, the student will have to cover the costs of possible medical treatment (in case of accidents during the CR) or other costs which emerged during his CR on his own.

8) SLOVENIAN LANGUAGE COURSES

Basic knowledge of Slovenian is highly recommended for exchange students applying for the clinical rotations and electives. We strongly advise you if not request from all incoming Erasmus+ students without basic knowledge of Slovenian to enrol themselves into intensive Slovene language course for Erasmus+, organised by the Center for Slovene, Faculty of Arts (60 hours, 3 ECTS). 9) REGISTRATION

Each incoming student will be registered as the exchange student at the Faculty of Medicine. Upon successful registration Student ID card, Erasmus+ Student Certificate will be provided to each officially registered student.

10) CENTRAL MEDICAL LIBRARY

If you wish you can register to the Central Medical Library by yourself. All registered Erasmus+ students have the access to all resources (journals, text books, electronic resources, etc.) of the Central Medical Library (CMK) (contact info: opening hours: 8.00-18.00 Mon-Fri, responsible officer: **Mrs. Nana Turk**, <http://www.mf.uni-lj.si/en/cmik/central-medical-library>; email: nana.turk@mf.uni-lj.si). Upon completion of your study at the Faculty of Medicine UL all materials have to be returned to CMK.

11) DEPARTURE

Before departure all Erasmus+ students must report to the International Office of the Faculty of Medicine, they have to present their final evaluation from the Department of Internal Medicine, Department of Surgery and Department of Family Medicine.

12) GRADES AND FINAL DOCUMENTS

The Faculty of Medicine will at the end of your exchange in Ljubljana prepare a Transcript of Records. In this document we will include all the passed study obligations with the appropriate ECTS credits as given in Ljubljana. We will as well add the grades of the exams you will do during your exchange in Ljubljana. According to the assessment forms from your home universities we will include the assessment grades of your CR in your final Transcript of records. Therefore, we are already now informing you that in case you will need the grades for the clinical rotations you will have to submit us prior to the beginning of your Clinical rotations a correspondent document from your home university from which it will be clear which skills and what knowledge should be assessed by your mentor.

13) WARDROBE

In order to get access to the wardrobe lockers at the Faculty of Medicine (Korytkova street 2, 2nd basement; if you take the elevator to 2nd basement, then turn left, the first door on your left) the students will have to arrange access on the basis of a Student ID card or URBANA card URBANA card, which is as well used for the public transport. For more information on how to get one please read the information about public transport written below.

You activate the wardrobe lockers at the Student office (Vrazov trg 2, first floor, "Referat za dodiplomski študij", office number 1).

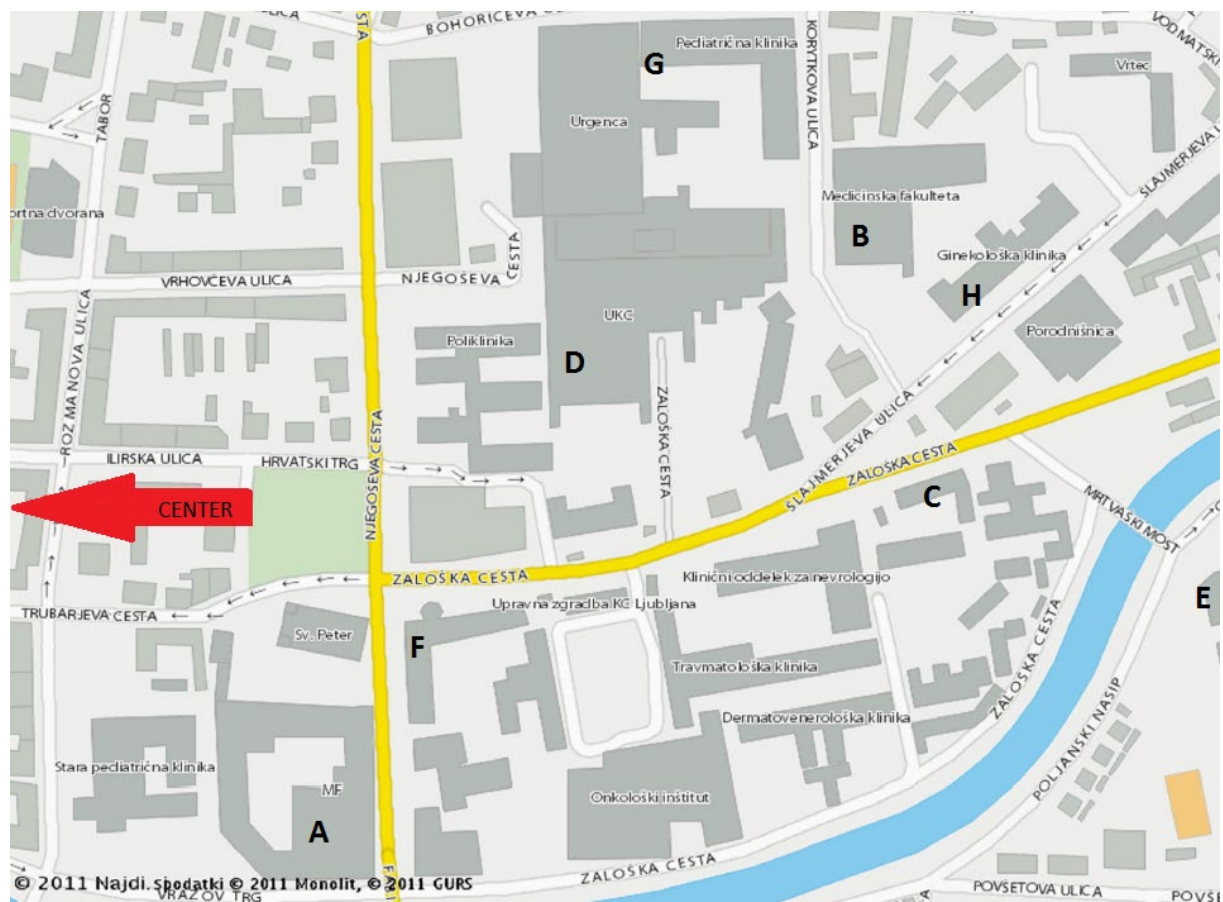

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

HOW TO GET THERE?

BY AIR: Ljubljana Jože Pučnik Airport is the main airport of the country. It is located 30 km from the centre of Ljubljana and has good connections with other European cities. Different options of public transport take you from the airport to Ljubljana in around half an hour.

The ticket for the bus from the Airport to Ljubljana costs 4,10 € and can be bought in the bus. The Journey takes 45 minutes and the last stop is the Central Bus Station in Ljubljana. HOW TO GET AROUND?

BUS – CITY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

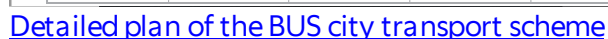
City buses have electronic payment system based on no-contact smart card called Urbana. Urbana cards are electronic ticket carriers. **URBANA value card (yellow)** is without a name of the holder and is transferable. You can buy and top it up with credit up to 50 € (at Urbanomat



Both types of cards are valid on all Ljubljana city bus routes. The credit does not lapse. The payment must be made at the beginning of the ride by touching with your card at one of the green readers (validators) on the bus. One fare will cost you 1,30 € including 90 min ride within all the City Public Transport bus routes. However, you should validate your card (touch the reader with the card Urbana) every time you enter the bus. To pay for two or more passengers, please tell the bus driver – before validation at the driver's reader (validator) – that you wish to buy more than one ticket and how many would you like to buy. The passengers you paid for should during the ride stay near you.

All tickets are carried on Urbana cards. Value ticket: single fare paid from pre-paid credit on Urbana card that enables free transfers within 90 minutes. Personalised monthly tickets: valid for an unlimited number of rides on all routes from the 1st day of the month until the 5th day of the following month. No photo necessary. A range of monthly tickets is available, some of them at subsidised prices. For more information, please enquire at LPP Information Centre. BICIKE LJ – CITY BIKE USE

Open 7 days a week, 24 hours a day, Bikelj system enables you to travel freely by day or night. Whether you use the system regularly or just occasionally, you can make an unlimited number of trips over the period of your subscription. Bikelj system stations consist of a main terminal and individual stands to which the bikes are attached (<https://aboen-ljubljana.cyclocity.fr/All-Stations/Station-Map>). Located in busy residential and shopping areas and near public transport, the stations are a simple and quick way to get around for a quick errand, the daily commute to work or getting to your favourite leisure activities. Whether starting a journey, ending a journey, or bridging the gap between two forms of transport, Bikelj system encourages intermodality and eco-friendly choices. Simplicity itself to use: it takes only a few minutes to hire or return a bike.

The system is easy to use. If you are planning to use this option more often it is advisable to subscribe as long-term subscriber. For just 3€ you can hire a bike as often as you wish over one-year period. The first hour period of each journey is free. After 60 minutes you pay the appropriate hourly hire rate. FIRST RESIDENCE PERMIT (EU CITIZEN)

As from May 1st 2004 any citizen from the EU member state can enter Slovenia with a valid identity card or a valid passport, without a special entrance permit (i.e. a visa or residence permit). This holds true no matter what the purpose of entry and stay in Slovenia is. For the first three months of stay in Slovenia the person does not need a residence permit. However, we oblige the students to apply for the residence permit and report to the Police immediately.

The residence permit can be obtained from the administrative office within the residential district (for Ljubljana: Office for passports and Aliens/Odsek za tujce, Tobačna 5, Ljubljana). The residence permit will be issued in accordance to the conditions set by the EU. In order to issue the residence permit to a citizen from an EU member state country for the purpose of study the following conditions have to be met:

- A valid identity card or passport,
- Evidence of enrolment at an educational institution,
- Health insurance covering all risks in the host member state,

- Sufficient means for living (higher than the level under which the host country approves social aid to its citizen). According to the practice of the EU`s court a statement handed in writing and signed by the student as to his means is sufficient.

According to the states directive the residence permit is granted for the period of studies or at the most for one year and can be extended in the event that the studies last for over a year.

FIRST RESIDENCE PERMIT AND MEDICAL INSURANCE (NON EU CITIZEN)

At your nearest Diplomatic or Consular representative office of the Republic of Slovenia you must submit an application for First Residence Permit before your arrival. EATING OUT

Being an exchange student, you can use a system of subsidized student meals. The system is used in the majority of restaurants in Ljubljana and in other cities in Slovenia. The subvention for meals in 2025 is 4,10 €. To be able to register you need your mobile phone for identification and the student card issued by the University of Ljubljana. More information about the system and the registration can be found on: <https://www.studentska-prehrana.si/en> In order to finish the preregistration procedure you will need the so called personal registration number which the international office will provide you in the beginning of your exchange.

The influence of the East and West, North and South have mingled in Slovenia, a phenomenon noticeable in Slovenia`s traditional dishes. The city of Ljubljana offers a great variety of cuisine and prices. Most restaurants serve food until 11 p.m., but some do so until the early morning. There are also numerous specialised national restaurants: Chinese, Italian, Mexican, Thai and Spanish. The tip is not included in the price of the meal and is not obligatory. In general, eating out in restaurants outside the system of subsidized student meals is not cheap.

WORKING IN SLOVENIA

Students wishing to seek for a long-term employment in Slovenia need to obtain a work permit. Exchange students, however, do not need a work permit. The easiest way for foreign students to obtain part-time jobs is at so-called Študentski servis (ŠS) – a service providing information about part time jobs for students. The ŠS is a mediator between companies and students and with the help of ŠS, you usually get less demanding, non-professional jobs (e.g. teachers/instructors for foreign languages or music, computer programmers and translators. To get a job you are required to obtain a Slovene tax number (Tax Office Ljubljana, Davčna ulica 1, Ljubljana; Office hours: Monday 8.00-

12.00 and 13.00-15.00, Tuesday 8.00-12.00 and 13.00-15.00, Wednesday 8.00-12.00 and 13.00-18.00 and Friday 8.00-13.00 (and a bank account in one of the Slovene banks).

LEISURE ACTIVITIES

Ljubljana and University of Ljubljana offer to the students a rich and varied selection of sports and cultural activities, ranging from athletic teams, choirs, photo and film clubs, dance and theatre groups. In addition various departments of the University have their own cultural and sports activities. The city has as well 12 cinemas, well stocked with most current movies without synchronisation. Foreign films are shown with Slovene subtitles. For most cultural events and entertainment special prices for students are offered.
